### Day 1

#### **BRUCHIM HABAIM – WELCOME TO ISRAEL**

- Check-in at our hotel in Tel Aviv from 3:00 PM
- Welcome to Israel Dinner
- Orientation Session

### DAY 2

### THE STRUGGLE FOR JEWISH RIGHTS & INDEPENDENCE

- Depart to IDC Reichman University in Herzliyah to learn about telling Israel's story on-line.
- Lunch on your own at IDC
- "Join" a Palmach unit at the museum dedicated to this elite force of the pre-State Haganah. Learn about the Jewish struggle for independence and survival
- Session with Israel advocacy expert Neil Lazarus
- Evening and dinner on your own in Tel Aviv

### DAY 3

## JERUSALEM – THE HEART OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE FOR OVER 3,000 YEARS

- Step back 3,000 years to the days of King David and the days of the First Temple at the latest archeological finds at the City of David (the original Jerusalem).
- At the Davidson Southern Temple Mount Archeological Park, step back 2,000 years to the days of the Second Temple. Examine the centrality of the Temple experience in Jewish tradition
- Mahaneh Yehudah Shuk for lunch and shopping time on your own.
- Return to the hotel to prepare for Shabbat (Shabbat Candle lighting 4:15 PM).
- Option: Depart to the Kotel.
- Join thousands welcoming Shabbat at the Kotel with prayer, song & dance (weather permitting)
- Walk back to the hotel for Shabbat dinner with IDF Lone Soldiers
- Oneg Shabbat after dinner

### DAY 4

### SHOMRON: HISTORICAL AND SECURITY HEART OF ISRAEL

- Visit Ariel, one of the largest communities in Shomron. At the industrial park, meet Israelis and Palestinians who work together.
- Get a sense of Jewish roots going back thousands of years at Shiloh which served as the home of the mishkan (Tabernacle) and spiritual center of the people of Israel over 3,000 years ago
- Ascend to Jerusalem.
- Check-in and <u>dinner</u> at our hotel in Jerusalem

### DAY 5 SHABBAT IN JERUSALEM - PARSHAT VAYECHI

- Enjoy the special atmosphere of Shabbat in Jerusalem by participating in Shabbat services at one of Jerusalem's many synagogues or take time to explore the city on your own
- Light Seudah Shlishit followed by ZOA Staff Session and Havdallah (5:27 PM)
- Session at the hotel with Khaled Abu Toameh, Arab Affairs Correspondent for the Jerusalem Post: Can Israel and the Palestinian Authority Make Peace?
- Dinner and evening on your own

#### DAY 6 FACING HAMAS

- Head to the embattled city of Sederot which has endured years of bombardment by Palestinian rockets from Gaza.
- Visit a local school and meet the kids see how daily life continues despite the threats.
- See the Sederot playground which doubles as a bomb shelter
- Join IDF Col. Grisha Yakubovich to visit front line Israeli positions on the border with Hamas controlled Gaza
- Return to Jerusalem; evening and dinner on your own

## DAY 7 JEWISH RIGHTS IN THE JEWISH HOMELAND

- Depart to Hevron City of the Patriarchs and Matriarchs.
- Meet Yishai Fleischer and visit Maarat HaMachpelah. Learn about the challenges facing the Jewish community in Hevron
- At the Kfar Etzion Heritage Center, see the audio-visual presentation of Jewish settlement between Jerusalem & Hevron through the ages.
- Meet with Roots/Judur/Shorashim: The Palestinian Israeli Initiative for Understanding, Nonviolence, & Reconciliation that brings together Jews & Arabs who live in the Efrat/Gush Etzion area for dialogue.
- Session with Efrat Mayor Oded Revivi: Are Settlements an Obstacle to Peace?
- Return to Jerusalem.
- Evening on your own as Jerusalem rings in the New Year!

### DAY 8 MEETING ISRAELI LEADERS

- Head to the Knesset for meetings and briefings with Members of Knesset
- Head north through the Jordan River Valley understand why this area plays a central role in Israel's security planning and negotiations and how BDS can negatively impact the local farmers.
- Continue north for <u>dinner</u> and a Kinneret boat ride in Tiberias

## DAY 9 ISRAEL'S NORTHERN BORDERS

Delve into the complex security and water issues on the Golan Heights, starting with a

**nature hike** at the beautiful **Tel Dan Nature Reserve** incorporating the headwaters of the Jordan River, the ancient Biblical City Dan and **views of Israel's border with Lebanon.** 

- Lunch on your own in Katzrin, "capital" of the Golan
- Join IDF Capt. (Res) Yaakov Selevan, meet IDF Soldiers, and see Israel's border with Syria to better understand the political and security situation and how Israel's presence on the Golan Heights serves as a deterrent to war.

**Overnight:** Tiberias

#### DAY 10 MOVING FORWARD

- Morning: Action plan sessions with ZOA staff
- Head to Mt. Carmel for lunch & encounter with the Israeli Arab Druze community.
- Visit the Mahmood Mosque and meet members of Haifa's Ahmadiyya Muslim community. Learn about their Islamic vision for coexistence.
- Summary Session and Farewell Dinner
- Depart to Ben Gurion International Airport for flights to the USA
- Bus will continue to Jerusalem
